

**RESOLUTION NO. LLA-011-002****DOUGLAS COUNTY LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY****A RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY OF  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, COLORADO, TO ELIMINATE CERTAIN TYPES OF  
SCHOOLS FROM THE APPLICATION OF STATUTORY DISTANCE  
RESTRICTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Board of County Commissioners Resolution R-009-142 created the Liquor Licensing Authority (the "Authority") for the purpose of reviewing, issuing and regulating beer and liquor licenses in the unincorporated areas of Douglas County, and delegated to the Authority all powers of the local licensing authority as set forth in Articles 46, 47 and 48, Title 12, C.R.S., as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, 12-47-313(d)(I) of the Liquor Code states that no malt, vinous, or spirituous liquor is to be sold in a building that is within five hundred feet of any public or parochial school with the exception of renewal or reissuance of a license once granted; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority finds that said distance restrictions have an unfair business impact on adjoining property owners when the school elects to locate within five hundred feet of existing liquor licensed establishments; and


**WHEREAS**, the Authority has the power to eliminate the application of the five hundred foot distance restriction as established in 12-47-313(d)(I) from one or more types of schools or campuses per 12-47-313(d)(III); and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Authority hereby eliminates from the application of the 500 foot distance restriction those schools that have elected to locate within five hundred feet of existing liquor licensed establishments.
