PURPOSE: To ensure all roadwork complies with Douglas County roadway design and construction standards.

DEPARTMENT RESPONSIBLE: Public Works

POLICY:

In order to ensure county compliance with Section 18-9-117(1) C.R.S., Section 30-11-107(1)(a), C.R.S., Section 30-11-107(1)(e), C.R.S., as well as compliance with County Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria and Roadway Design and Construction Standards, the following policy is adopted:

1. All excavation, construction, repair, and maintenance work within any county road, street, right-of-way, tract, easement or open space shall be in accordance with the Douglas County Roadway Design and Construction Standards adopted on April 11, 1990, and as the same may be amended from time to time, and in accordance with the Douglas County Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria adopted January 13, 1986, and as the same may be amended from time to time.
2. The Douglas County Engineer, or his authorized agent, is authorized to issue stop work orders prohibiting excavation, construction, repair, or maintenance work within any county road, street, right-of-way, tract, easement, or open space that is not in accordance with said Douglas County Roadway Design and Construction Standards and said Douglas County Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria.
3. Any excavation, construction, repair, or maintenance work within any county road, street, right-of-way, tract, easement, or open space that is not in accordance with said Douglas County Roadway Design and Construction Standards or said Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria shall be unlawful and shall be prosecuted

and punished in accordance with the applicable criminal statutes of the State of Colorado.
