- 2 playgrounds
- 3.06 miles of concrete trails
- 2 ballfields (baseball or softball use)
- 10 soccer or football fields
- Synthetic multi-purpose field and amphitheatre (has lights for night use)
- Sand volleyball court
- Multi-use hard surface court (basketball with 3 hoops)
- Picnic shelter: 3 sections (A, B, & C), seats 192 (64 per section),
- 3 drinking fountains
- 3 waterless restrooms
- Restroom on north side of Parks, Trails, and Building Grounds headquarters building
- Restroom and concession building (open from April-October)
- Parking for 625 cars
- Electricity and water available
