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STANDARD LIABILTY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Prior to a license or registration being issued, the contractor shall file with the building official, Certificates of Liability and Worker's Compensation Insurance. The insurance certificates must be signed by an agent of the insurance company stating that the policy or policies required by Douglas County have been issued to the licensee. The policy or policies shall state the name of the company, the effective date of such policies and the expiration date of such policies. Each policy of insurance shall contain an endorsement to the effect that the insurance carrier shall notify Douglas County Building Department of the effective date of a reduction or cancellation of the policy or policies. The cancellation or reduction of insurance below the required amount of coverage shall be cause for automatic suspension of the contractor's license or registration until coverage is reinstated. All policies shall be kept in effect for the period of the license.
