2. I/we will comply with the requirements of the Douglas County GESC Manual, as amended, specifically section 3.20.5;
3. I certify I am legally authorized to sign on behalf of and bind the above listed entity(s).

The GESC Permit is granted with the explicit understanding that it is the Permittees' responsibility to:

1. Schedule a preconstruction meeting at least 72 hours prior to the anticipated start of construction for each maintenance project;
2. Provide Douglas County with an annual list of projects to be covered by this permit and amend such list in accordance with section 3.20.5 of the GESC Manual;
3. Allow Douglas County unrestricted access to the site(s) to conduct regular site inspections;
4. Obtain legal access to all properties where work is to be conducted;
5. Comply with all requirements of the GESC Manual and GESC Permit;
6. Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of Douglas County. A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this Permit suspends if the Permittees are not in compliance with the GESC Permit, GESC Plan and/or GESC Manual, or the Permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance;
7. Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of this GESC Permit shall constitute a violation of Section 31 of the Douglas County Zoning Resolution; and
8. Understand any approval obtained from Douglas County does not obviate your need to comply with the requirements of the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Colorado Discharge Permit System, General Permit, Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 1531, *et seq.*, as amended, Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations.
