“When all GESC Plan review comments are addressed, the Applicant(s) will be notified by the County that the GESC Plan is preliminarily accepted (final acceptance occurs when additional copies of the GESC Drawings are submitted to the County and signed by the **Engineering Services Director**). **The County will require two stamped and signed GESC Drawing sets in addition to the number of sets that the applicant(s) need signed by the County.**”
