Request and Recommendation: Staff requests an opportunity to provide an update to the BOCC on potential changes to and regulatory requirements of the Cherry Creek Basin Regulation 72, CDPHE's CDPS Permit and EPA's General Stormwater Permit.

Discussion: Review issues and potential solutions regarding potential and existing requirements of the Cherry Creek Basin Regulation 72, correspondence from the CDPHE regarding the CDPS Permit, and potential requirements of the forthcoming EPA General Stormwater and Construction Permits, respectively.

Fiscal Impact: If the current regulations are not modified, and/or correspondence from the CDPHE regarding the CDPS Permit are incorporated into the next permit term for the County's CDPS Permit, and/or the forthcoming EPA General Stormwater and Construction Permits are adopted as proposed, significant financial impacts to Douglas County taxpayers and current and future businesses in Douglas County will occur.
