Park & Field Use Policies

For the safety of all players, the following rain & snow out policy will be implemented:

- If inclement weather conditions exist, your organization will be responsible for checking field status by calling our Weather Hotline (720) 733-6999. The weather hotline will be updated by 3:00 p.m. weekdays and 6:00 a.m. weekends.
- If inclement weather conditions occur after 3:00 p.m. or on weekends after 6:00 a.m., your organization's representative must exercise his or her own discretion. Excessive damage to the turf areas, infields or trash left on fields will result in an additional charge of \$40.00 per man-hour to the user group, plus the cost of materials & equipment to make any necessary repairs. It will be the responsibility of the user group to notify Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds office if a field has not been used due to weather as soon as is reasonable.
- Rain & Snow out make up games may be made up 7 days after the original date. Users will need to schedule any make-up time with the Parks office within 24 hours of cancellation to insure field availability.

2012 Payment Policy Douglas County Organized User Group

Spring Season

User groups whose season begins during March will be required to remit one-half of the total payment by Friday, February 24, 2012. Final payment will be due no later than, Friday, April 13, 2012.

Summer Season

User groups whose season begins during May or June will be required to remit one-half of the total payment by Friday, May 11, 2012. Final payment will be due no later than, Friday, July 13, 2012.

Fall Season

User groups whose season begins during August or September will be required to remit one-half of the total payment by Friday, August 10, 2012. Final payment will be due no later than, Friday, October 13, 2012.

Winter Season

User groups whose season begins during November or December will be required to remit one-half of the total payment by Friday, November 16, 2012. Final payment will be due no later than, Friday, December 14, 2012.

Tournaments & Special Events

Special events such as tournaments, tryouts, etc. payment will be due in full upon receipt of contract.

If payment has not been received by Douglas County Parks, Trails and Building Grounds by the date stated, lights will be turned off and the delinquent organization's future requests will not be processed until all past due and currently due payments are paid in full. All groups will be invoiced by Douglas County Finance Department. Please send payment with invoice to address below.

Field Open & Closed Dates

Natural turf fields are closed November 15th through March 1st. Synthetic turf fields may be used year-round, weather permitting. If ice or snow is present, no synthetic field use will be permitted. If ice or snow is present on natural turf fields prior to November 15th, no field use will be permitted. If you are on the field (synthetic or natural) and it starts snowing and begins to stick, you must cease play and vacate the field. If this policy is violated you will be charged a minimum fee of \$500.00. For each additional occurrence, a \$50.00 charge will be added on to the last amount charged (i.e. 2nd occurrence \$550.00). Continued violation will cause the user's privileges to be revoked.

Field Lights

The field lights are controlled by an internet based sports lighting scheduling system which will automatically turn the lights on & off according to the schedule given by the user group. It is the sole responsibility of that field's user group to provide Douglas County with a schedule. Schedules must be given to Douglas County at least three day's in advance and must be accurate according to practice & game times for each day. Being organized and responsible is highly recommended in avoiding mis-use of lights. Each user group must assign a designated representative to make a phone call (Control Link 877-347-3319) to turn off the lights in the event practices or games are canceled or end earlier than scheduled for reasons other than closure of fields due to weather. If lights are left on according to your schedule and the field is not in use, you will receive one written warning in the form of an email. If there is a 2nd violation there will be no warning issued and there will be a minimum charge of \$500.00. For each additional occurrence, a \$50.00 charge will be added on to the last amount charged (i.e. 3rd occurrence \$550.00). Continued violation (i.e. 4 violations within a year) will cause the user's privileges to be revoked. Field lights will be turned on no earlier than 15 minutes prior to dusk.

Snow Removal

Snow removal by user groups is not allowed on any field including synthetic fields. If snow is plowed, blown off, shoveled, swept, foot stomped etc., there will be a minimum fee of \$500.00 for damages to irrigation heads, turf, fencing, concrete, light poles, etc. Additional amounts will be charged if appropriate under the circumstances. For each additional occurrence, a \$50.00 charge will be added on to the last amount charged (i.e. 2nd occurrence \$550.00). Continued violation (i.e. 3 violations within a year) will cause the user's privileges to be revoked. No group or individual coach shall be allowed to use the fields until all snow has been removed by the County, and the field use has been approved by Parks, Trails, and Building Grounds. Use of the fields prior to snow removal shall result in a \$500.00 fine to the user group involved.

Insurance Liability

All organized field User Groups will be required to provide insurance coverage per Douglas County Policy. (Refer to page 8)

Field Preparation

Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds will prepare field(s) for the FIRST game only each day to ensure safe playing conditions. It is the responsibility of the user group to continue maintenance on the field throughout the remainder of other games (fill in holes, rake, and line if needed). NOTE: No motorized vehicles are allowed on any fields. Once fields have been prepped no re-prep will be done by Douglas County due to inclement weather. Field preparations will not be done on holidays. At least three day's notice must be given to have a field prepped by Douglas County.

Field Reservations

Once fields have been reserved by an organization and a confirming park reservation permit has been issued by Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds, there will be no refunds unless games are canceled due to inclement weather and cannot be rescheduled. If a User Group cancels due to inclement weather notification must be sent to Douglas County vial email llee@douglas.co.us by 9:00 a.m. the next business day. If notification is not received by 9:00 a.m. no refunds will be processed. If a field has been reserved and permitted and is not used or vacant for any reason other than a County field closure for inclement weather, without notice to the county, the user group's future requests will be re-evaluated. Only the organization reserving the field is allowed to play on the field. NO SUB-LEASING of any field is allowed.

Keys

Keys will be issued to user groups for scorekeepers buildings if applicable and must be returned to the Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds Department at the end of the season. For any keys lost or damaged there will be a \$500.00 charge, if duplicate keys are needed due to misuse, damage etc. there will be a \$25.00 charge. No lock is to be changed without permission from Douglas County. If any locks are cut, Douglas County will assess damages against the responsible user group and re-evaluate future use of fields.

Scorekeepers Booth

The scorekeeper's booth is the sole responsibility of the user group that reserves the field. The booth must be cleaned daily, and all trash removed immediately.

Soccer Goals (4V4 & 6V6)

Soccer goals are to be removed from soccer fields at the end of weekend play and stacked, stored, and secured in designated area(s). Areas for storage will be determined by Douglas County staff prior to season play with user group representative(s). If goals are not moved to designated area the user group will be charged a \$50.00 fee per occurrence.

Restrooms, Litter Receptacles for Special Events & Tournaments

Tournament play and large events may require additional restroom facilities, litter receptacles and traffic control.* Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds reserves the right to mandate these additional items based on size of event. If additional items are required, Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds Staff will schedule necessary units and the user group will be responsible for the additional expenses.

The user group will be responsible for trash pick up throughout the event and making sure to re-stock toilet paper if needed.

*For large events, user groups must contact Sergeant Gary Butler in the Douglas County Sheriff's Department at (303) 660-7500 to hire necessary Sheriff Staff to direct traffic, etc.

Contact(s)

For after-hour park use emergencies contact the Douglas County Sheriff's Office at (303) 660-7500 or call 911 if the circumstances warrant. They will dispatch Park Rangers or Parks Maintenance staff if needed or law enforcement personnel if appropriate.

Permits

The original "Douglas County Parks, Trails & Building Grounds Park Reservation Permit" must be signed and returned along with proof of insurance before the first game or practice, for field preparations to take place. No organized practice, games, etc. will be allowed without a reservation permit.

Priority for Reserving Fields

The following is the reservation priority policy for groups who schedule County fields as well as other County park facilities:

- Reservations for all four seasons (spring, summer, fall, winter) per year (also include request's through February of 2013 for synthetic fields) are to be completed no later than 4:00 p.m. January 31, 2012 and turned in to the Parks, Trails & Building Grounds Administration Office at 9651 S. Quebec St., Littleton, CO 80130, faxed to (303) 470-0916 or emailed to jlandson@douglas.co.us. Any requests received after this date and time will not be accepted.
- Priority of use for overlapping requests is as follows:
 - Douglas County organized groups in good standing with prior history of usage
 - New Douglas County organized groups
 - Non Douglas County groups in good standing with prior history of usage
 - Douglas County residents who are not part of organized groups
 - Non-Douglas County residents or groups without prior history of usage
- After all initial permits are issued, any additional reservations will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Any violations of the field use policy will be enforced at the discretion of the Assistant Director of Parks, Trails & Building Grounds or his designee.

Synthetic Turf Information

To preserve the quality of the turf and provide a clean and healthy environment, the following are prohibited on the synthetic turf fields:

- No heaters (gas or electric)
- No scaffolding
- No tables
- No metal cleats on athletic shoes
- No motorized vehicles
- No cigarettes or tobacco products of any kind
- No fireworks
- No pets of any kind
- No sunflower seeds or shelled nuts of any kind
- Only free standing field markers and sports equipment may be used on the synthetic turf surface. No stakes, posts, poles or markers of any kind may be driven into the synthetic turf surface.

Do NOT dispose of the following items on the turf:

- Gum
- Food
- Hard candy
- Soda, juice, etc.

Douglas County requires that all user groups be responsible for the action(s) of all its users. It will be the responsibility of the user group to educate its users on the dos and don'ts on the synthetic fields. If damage is done to due to negligence you will be held liable for damages and clean up billed at a rate of \$40.00 per man hour plus Equipment. If there are more than 3 occurrences in a season Douglas County reserves the right to revoke your permit and suspend use.

User Responsibility and County Indemnity Insurance:

1. The applicant agrees to procure and maintain with insurers with an A- or better rating as determined by Best's Key Rating Guide, at its own expense, the following policy of insurance:
 - a. Commercial General Liability insurance with minimum combined single limits of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) each occurrence and TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) aggregate. The policy will be applicable to all premises and operations. The policy will include coverage for bodily injury, broad form property damage (including completed operations), personal injury (including coverage for contractual and employee acts), blanket contractual, independent contractors, products, and completed operations. The policy will contain a severability of interest provision.
2. The required Commercial General Liability policy will be endorsed to include Douglas County as a Certificate Holder and name Douglas County, its officers and employees as additional insureds.
3. The certificate of insurance will be provided to Douglas County by the Contractor's insurance agent or carrier as evidence that the policy providing the required coverage, conditions, and minimum limits are in full force and effect. The completed certificate of insurance and any notices, within 20 days of cancellation, termination or material change will be sent to:

4. The applicant understands that Douglas County is relying on, and does not waive or intend to waive by any provision of this policy, the monetary limitations (presently \$150,000 per person and \$600,000 per occurrence) or any other rights, immunities and protections provided by the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, Sections 24-10-101 et seq., C.R.S., as from time to time amended, or otherwise available to Douglas County, its officers, or its employees.

- Discharge of firearms or fireworks without prior approval
- Motorized vehicles and parking vehicles in other than designated areas
- Overnight camping
- Swimming or boating without prior approval
- Molestation of livestock
- Commercial activity without prior approval
- Any activity which is a hazard to the safety of other persons
- All alcohol except 3.2% alcohol – (no alcohol is to be sold)
