# TRAIL HISTORY

The Cherry Creek Greenway was originally conceived as a connector trail for hikers, bikers, and equestrians to Cherry Creek, Castlewood Canyon, and Chatfield State Parks. To date, approximately 17 of the 24 miles have been constructed. The trail will provide access not only to the state parks, but to neighborhoods, businesses, regional parks, and wildlife habitat.

# TRAIL ETIQUETTE



- Be friendly and courteous.
  - Share the trail. Ride, walk or run on the right, pass on the left.
  - Stay on the trail. Creating your own trail creates erosion, damages habitat and causes new trails which cannot be maintained.
  - Bicyclists yield to equestrians, runners and hikers. Keep your bike under control and at safe speed.
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- Runners and hikers yield to equestrians.
  - Downhill traffic should yield to uphill traffic. When in doubt, give the other user the right-of-way.
  - Use unpaved trails only when they are dry, not muddy or wet, to avoid leaving ruts or prints.
  - Announce or alert when you are planning to pass. Use a calm voice to warn equestrians, not bells or horns. Bells or horns may frighten horses.
  - Anticipate other trail users around corners and blind spots.
  - Respect wildlife. Keep your distance.
  - Use caution when using headphones. You may not be able to hear people trying to warn you.
  - When a horse approaches, move off the trail and ask the rider for instructions.
  - Leave no trace. Pack out your litter.
  - Dogs must be kept on leashes and under control.
  - Respect private property.
