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BALLOT ISSUE 5B

SHALL ARROWHEAD SHORES COMMUNITY CENTER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT DEBT BE INCREASED \$1,100,000, WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF \$1,754,821 (MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST), AND SHALL ARROWHEAD SHORES COMMUNITY CENTER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$116,995 ANNUALLY OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH DEBT AND ANY REFUNDINGS THEREOF (AT AN INTEREST RATE THAT IS EQUAL TO, LOWER OR HIGHER THAN THE INTEREST RATE ON THE REFUNDED DEBT), BY THE ISSUANCE OF DISTRICT GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, EQUIPPING AND IMPROVING THE BUILDING AND IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED AT 9755 S. CRYSTAL LAKE DRIVE, LITTLETON, COLORADO 80125, TO USE AS A PUBLIC RECREATION CENTER AND PAYING FEES AND COSTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS, SUCH GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 6.5% PER ANNUM, SUCH GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO BE PAID FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE REVENUES OF THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING THE PROCEEDS OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES, SUCH TAXES TO CONSIST OF AN AD VALOREM MILL LEVY IMPOSED ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE OR WITH SUCH LIMITATIONS AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO PRODUCE THE ANNUAL INCREASE SET FORTH ABOVE OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM, IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT; ALL OF THE ABOVE AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SUCH DEBT AND THE REVENUE FROM SUCH TAXES, OTHER REVENUE USED TO PAY SUCH DEBT AND INVESTMENT EARNINGS THEREON BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT, AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?

BALLOT ISSUE 5C

SHALL ARROWHEAD SHORES COMMUNITY CENTER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$225,000 (FIRST YEAR-2010) ANNUALLY, PLUS THE ADDITIONAL AMOUNT PER YEAR OF A \$5,000 INCREASE IN EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR (i.e. \$230,000 FOR 2011, \$235,000 FOR 2012 AND SO FORTH) WHICH SHALL BE RAISED BY A RATE OF MILL LEVY AGAINST ALL OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT AS NECESSARY TO PAY THE DISTRICT'S ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES, INCLUDING THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF A PUBLIC RECREATION CENTER, BY THE IMPOSITION OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES LEVIED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE OF MILL LEVY, AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND ANY INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT IN FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, THE LIMITS IMPOSED ON INCREASES IN PROPERTY TAXATION BY SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S. IN ANY YEAR, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, ALL WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?
