## Douglas County Elections Student Art Contest Rules and Entry Form

- Drawings, paintings, and graphic design are all acceptable. Submissions must be able to be mounted and framed for viewing in Douglas County offices. Artwork must be no smaller than 8" x 10" and no larger than 18" x 24".
- Consistent with current public health guidelines, students will electronically submit their entry form and a digital photo of their artwork to: clerk@douglas.co.us. Students without internet access/digital photo capability may call Douglas County Elections, 303-660-7444, to arrange for delivery of their artwork. The submission deadline is September 18, 2020.
- Judges will review each submission. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be selected in each grade category. Honorable Mentions will be awarded to the top 50 submissions, regardless of grade category.
- Winners will be announced by October 5, 2020. All winners will receive Award Certificates, Douglas County press release and social media recognition, and display of artwork in Douglas County office buildings.
- Winners will be contacted directly to arrange for delivery of their artwork to Douglas County Elections.
