2021 Douglas County Grant Application Developmental Disabilities Mill Levy Grant Due July 16, 2021

Overview

Developmental Disabilities Mill Levy (DDML) grant awards are allocated through an annual competitive grant process. An application for funding includes an Organizational Profile, Proposal Details and Attachments. The funds may only be used in support of Douglas County residents with an intellectual or developmental disability (I/DD) as defined by the State of Colorado. Most awards are made in a one-time payment. The County seeks to make grant awards in support of programs, projects or scholarships for residents, as opposed to administrative costs or operating expenses. Applications will be reviewed by the DDML Advisory Council in the third quarter of 2021 and make funding recommendations to the Douglas County Board of County Commissioners in the fall. Contracts with grantees will be prepared in the fourth quarter for use during 2022. A final report is required upon completion.

Instructions

You may propose more than one request for funds. Only one Organizational Profile is needed, even if multiple requests are submitted. Use a separate fillable form for each request for services, trips, personal care, respite, adult day or vehicle purchase. Provide one set of attachments with the Organizational Profile and the attachment cover sheets to separate the attachments. If you submit more than one request for funds, submit an Attachment B3, Program Budget, and Attachment I, Unit Cost Spreadsheet, specific to each request.
