## Roadway improvements in Pradera

### Project Summary

Douglas County is improving Bayou Gulch Road between Pradera Parkway and Scott Avenue by installing a new storm sewer system, asphalt pavement, and a continuous sidewalk.

After construction, the entire road - from Pradera Parkway to Scott Avenue - will have one lane in each direction paved with asphalt, three-foot shoulders, and a continuous concrete sidewalk.

Construction will begin in June 2023 and is expected to be completed in May 2024. Ultimately - when traffic volume warrants - two lanes in each direction will be paved with asphalt.

## Project Funding

This project is 100% funded by Douglas County, using road sales and use tax revenue. Voters approved this 0.4% sales and use tax in 1995 and extended it in 2007. This funding is specifically designated to the improvement and maintenance of County roads and bridges. Some funding is shared back to the five municipalities within Douglas County.

This project cost does not include any developer contributions or impact fees.



## Transportation is a Priority

A safe and efficient transportation network is foundational to economic prosperity and your quality of life. In partnership with others, Douglas County is making historic investments to address present and future mobility demands.

In 2023, 50% of the County's budget will be invested in capital and maintenance projects countywide. That's \$248 million to increase safety and mobility for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians.

Most of the funding for transportation projects comes from sales and use taxes, user fees and voter-approved measures specifically for transportation projects. To stretch your dollars, the County works with public and private partners at the local, regional, state and federal levels. Most new construction projects in Douglas County include funding from partner organizations.
