

Work begins on trail and new bridge over Yosemite Street & C-470 on-ramp



OVERVIEW

In December, Douglas County began installation of a pedestrian bridge with the extension of a multiuse trail/sidewalk on the north side of S. Yosemite Street and the C-470 on-ramp. This project is expected to continue through December 2022.


The current trail requires pedestrians and cyclists to cross at the busy intersection of Yosemite and C-470. The new pedestrian bridge will reroute the trail over this intersection and create a safer, more convenient connection for pedestrians and cyclists. This extension also provides a new 10-foot wide multi-use trail and will improve mobility by reducing congestion and traffic delays on Yosemite Street related to C-470 trail users interfacing with motorists.

PROJECT SCHEDULE & TRAVEL IMPACTS

- During construction, the existing trail access will be closed. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured via Yosemite Street, Parkway Drive and ultimately rejoin the C-470 Trail from both east and west directions (see detour map on next page).
- On Yosemite Street and the C-470 on-ramp, motorists can expect intermittent single-lane traffic with flaggers assisting motorists through the work zone.
- Normal work hours will be Monday through Thursday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Friday from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. There will be occasional brief closures to allow crews safe passage through the work zone.
- During the bridge construction (happening fall 2022), overnight full lane closures on Yosemite Street and full on-ramp closures will be necessary.
