Framing the Process

HMA is conducting the Douglas County CHA and PHIP using a modified version of the Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships (MAPP) because:


The nature of this process is exploratory. Once the Douglas County Public Health Department is further along in its development, then the time and resources required for a full-blown process can be allocated.

The 2018 CHA and 2019-2024 PHIP created by Tri-County Department of Public Heath provides Douglas County with a starting point.


MAPP was created by the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) and the CDC in 2001. NACCHO is the only organization dedicated to serving local health departments in the nation.

Using a modified MAPP process provides Douglas County a framework to conduct a full CHA and PHIP in the future.


























