

## Summary of Capacity Differences Between Level Yellow and Level Blue in Douglas County, Colorado

On April 5, 2021 CDPHE amended the *COVID-19 Dial 3.0*. Following is a summary of capacity limitations for Level Yellow and Level Blue on the *Dial*. More information from CDPHE can be found at: <https://covid19.colorado.gov/>

<b>Business or Activity</b>	<b>Level Yellow</b>	<b>Level Blue</b>
Aquariums, Museums, and Similar Educational Institutions	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 150 people, per room (excluding staff).	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 175 people, per room (excluding staff).
Bars (that do not serve food)	Closed.	25% of capacity, not to exceed 75 people.
Camps (Day, Residential, Sports, or Skill-Building)	May be conducted with up to 10 participants indoors and 25 outdoors.	May be conducted with up to 25 participants indoors and 50 outdoors.
Events, Indoors (receptions, conferences, etc.)	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 150 people, per room (excluding staff).	Seated: 100% of posted occupancy per room with 6 feet separation between groups of 10 individuals. Consultation with CDPHE required for events that exceed 500 people. Unseated: 50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 175 people, per room (excluding staff).
Events, Outdoors (receptions, conferences, etc.)	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 175 people, per activity or area (excluding staff).	May operate in full.
Field Services	May operate. Real estate open houses must follow Indoor Event requirements.	May operate. Real estate open houses must follow Indoor Event requirements.
Gyms	50% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area. Establishments larger than 7,200 SF may expand to up to 100 patrons per room.	100% of occupancy, with 6 feet distancing between non-household members.
High School Sports	May resume practices and games under disease prevention and mitigation plans prepared by CHSSA and approved by CDPHE.	May resume practices and games under disease prevention and mitigation plans prepared by CHSSA and approved by CDPHE.
Houses of Worship (and associated ceremonies)	May provide services under Critical Business guidelines.	May provide services under Critical Business guidelines.
Indoor Mall	Park Meadows variance remains in place: 50% capacity per confined space up to 175.	Park Meadows variance remains in place: 50% capacity per confined space up to 175.

Recreation Centers and Pools	50% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area. Establishments larger than 7,200 SF may expand to up to 100 patrons per room.	100% of occupancy, with 6 feet distancing between non-household members.
Restaurants	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 150 people, per room (excluding staff).	100% of posted occupancy, with 6 feet distancing between non-household members.
Retail, Critical and Non-critical	Allowed to operate at 75% of posted occupancy.	Allowed to operate at 75% of posted occupancy.
Social Gatherings	Follow CDC guidance on gatherings.	Follow CDC guidance on gatherings.
Recreational League Sports	Activities with no more than 25 players (excluding coaching staff and referees or umpires) are allowed. Leagues may request permission from CDPHE to operate in accordance with CHSSA requirements.	Activities with no more than 50 players (excluding coaching staff and referees or umpires) are allowed. Leagues may request permission from CDPHE to operate in accordance with CHSSA requirements.
