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## ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

Electrical permit fees are reviewed annually and may be adjusted as necessary. Fees are based on *either* RESIDENTIAL or ALL OTHER FEES. Do not use *both* categories to determine your fee. If an electrical permit is not filed <u>in advance</u> of the commencement of an installation, the inspection fee may be twice the amount as prescribed by Colorado Revised Statute §12-115-121.3

**Section A. RESIDENTIAL**: In unincorporated Douglas County, a single Residential Building Permit Fee covers all building, electrical, mechanical and plumbing work included on the approved plans.

**Section B.** ALL OTHER FEES including <u>some residential installations that are not based on square footage (not in a living area, i.e. garage, shop, and photovoltaic, etc.). Fees in this section are calculated from the total cost to customer, including electrical materials, items and labor – whether provided by the contractor or the property owner. Use this chart for a service connection, a temporary meter, and all commercial installations. Such fees shall be computed as follows: (See 'C' below for the permit fees for mobile/modular home and travel trailer parks).</u>

Valuation of Installation: (based on cost to customer of labor, materials, and items):

**Example**: The cost of the installation is \$8,150 (round up to \$9,000)

The base fee is calculated from section (2) above: 9 x \$5=\$45 PLUS \$57 =\$102

The total fee is: \$102
