#### WHAT TO KNOW

- Registered Democrats receive the Democratic Primary/Vacancy Election ballot.
- Registered Republicans receive the Republican Primary/Vacancy Election ballot.
- Unaffiliated voters receive two
   Primary/Vacancy Election ballots, one
   Democratic and one Republican but
   must vote and return ONLY ONE.
- Minor Party voters not participating in a Primary Election will only receive the Vacancy Election ballot.







#### WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT?

- Republican and Democratic Primary ballots will each have candidates for Federal, State, and County offices. The winner of each contest will appear on the November General Election ballot.
- Each Primary ballot also includes the SPECIAL CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 4 VACANCY ELECTION. The winner of this election will serve the rest of the unexpired term for United States Congress District 4, starting in July 2024 and ending in January 2025.
- NOTE: Effective January 7, 2025,
   Douglas County moves from the 18th
   Judicial District to the newly created
   23rd Judicial District. As a result,
   candidates on the ballot for the office
   of District Attorney will now be listed
   for the 23rd Judicial District.
