**Subject:** Update on Douglas County Entryway Signs

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### Summary

This item is an update regarding the Douglas County Entryway Signs project.

### Discussion

A work session was held with the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) to provide information regarding the proposed Entryway Sign Project and receive feedback. The work session identified two phases of the project.

**Phase 1** - Install Type II ("Douglas County", with slogan) signs at roadway entry points.

**Status:** The attached map identifies the locations of the existing Type I County entry signs. These signs will be replaced with new Type II signs, by County staff, once the design and slogan have been finalized, see attached examples.

**Phase 2** - Design and install iconic gateway signage (monument style signs) located at the north and south end of Douglas County along I-25.

**Status:** Staff has selected Cushing Terrell through a referral process to design the gateway signage. The design process will include presentation of options to the BOCC for final selection of the conceptual design. The process will also include proposed sign locations. Once the conceptual design has been approved, detailed construction documents will be provided.

**Estimated Cost Projection:** Based on most recent monument sign cost for Castle Pines of \$681,000 in 2023, Construction of the two monument signs is estimated at \$750,000 per sign, for a total amount of \$1,500,000. Funding is proposed to come from Business Unit 800100 in Fund 200.

## Next Steps

**Phase 1** - Finalize the Type II sign design. Staff is currently showing the slogan, "Where Quality of Life Comes First". Staff is prepared to make and install the new signs once the design is approved by the BOCC.

**Phase 2** - Schedule the design contract with Cushing Terrell for approval by the BOCC at an upcoming regular Business Meeting. The design contract will be in the amount of \$143,640.

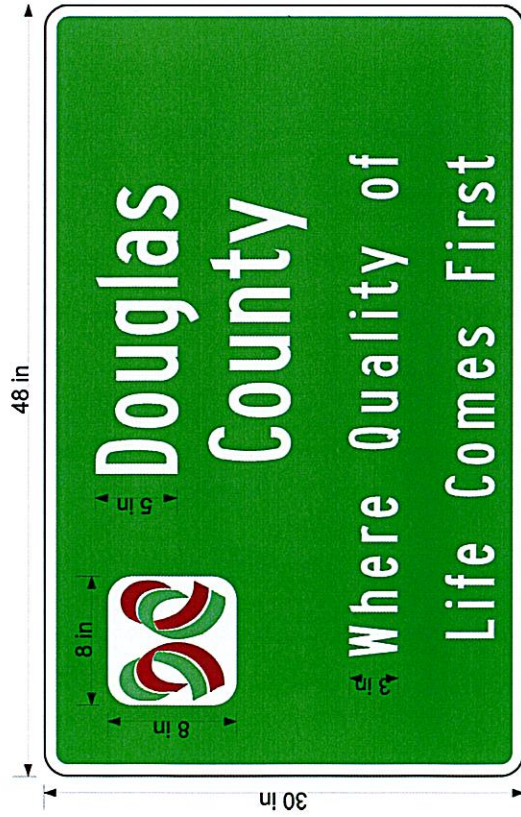

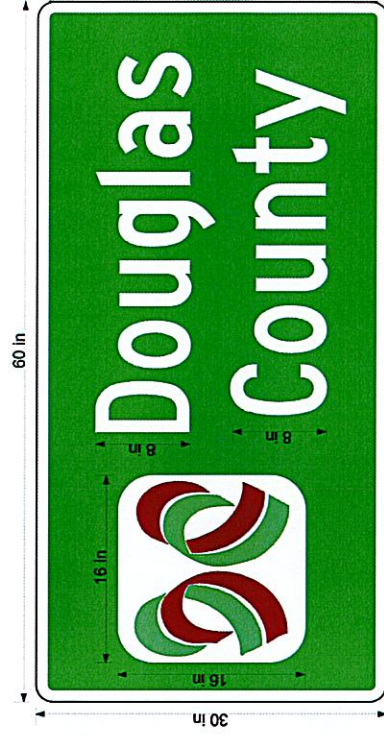
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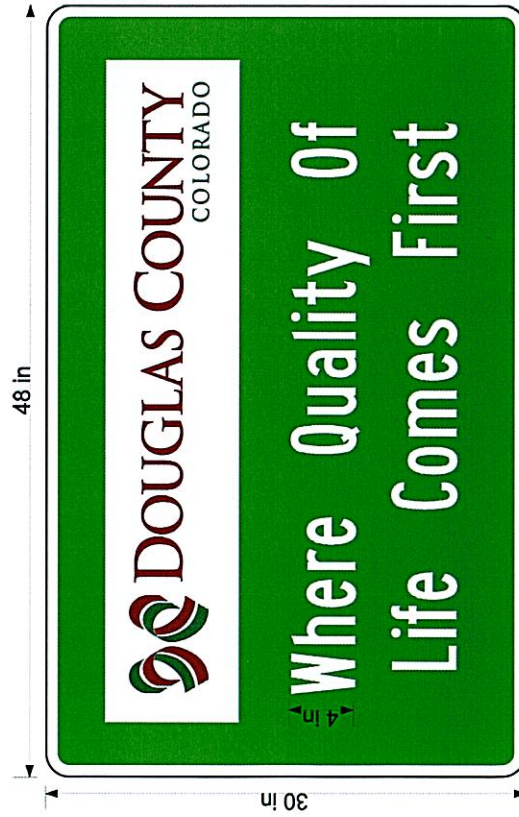
