## Pinery Loop Trail



### Users:

- Bicyclists
- Dogs on-leash
- Hikers

### Trail Rating:

- Beginner to intermediate
- Elevation and surface changes
- Abundant wildlife and vistas

### Trail Length:

- About 4 miles on County open space tracts and County right-of-way
- Connects users to the Cherry Creek Regional Trail

### Trail Surface:

- This trail leads users through soft and hard surfaces of rolling terrain

### Amenities:

- Picnic area
- Restrooms
- Parking at Bingham Lake

### Location:

In Parker, off of Highway 83 (Parker Road) and N. Pinery Parkway.

**NOTE:** Trail users may also enter the Pinery Loop Trail from the Cherry Creek Regional Trail located approximately 0.5 miles west of State Highway 83 via a connecting trail and underpass.
