PASSPORTS What You Will Need

Completed Forms

You can plan ahead and complete the necessary **DS-11 form** prior to your visit to make the process move faster.



Personal Photo

You must provide one photograph with your application. To avoid processing delays, be sure your photo meets all requirements.

The Douglas County Recording Office provides photo services for an additional fee. Your photograph fee may be paid by cash, check, money order or credit card made payable to Douglas County Clerk.

Proof of U.S. Citizenship & Government-Issued Photo ID

The most common documents needed to apply for a passport are a **certified copy of a U.S.**birth certificate and a current driver license.

Payment

Please note that the passport fee may be paid with personal check, money order or bank draft made payable to U.S. Department of State.

The processing and photo fee (if applicable) may be paid by cash, check, money order or credit card made payable to Douglas County Clerk.





You must apply for your passport in person if at least one of the following is true:

- You are applying for your first U.S. passport
- Your previous U.S. passport was issued when you were under age 16
- Your previous U.S. passport was lost, stolen, or damaged
- · Your previous U.S. passport was issued more than 15 years ago

If none of the above statements apply to you, you may be eligible to renew by mail.

If you are applying for a passport for your child, there are additional considerations to keep in mind:

- All children, even infants, must appear in person with their application before it can be accepted
- The name on the child's birth certificate must match the name on the parents/guardians ID. (Can be maiden or married last name)
- For children under the age of 16: both parents/guardians must appear in person or you can bring a consent form signed by an absent parent
- For children born outside the US, please contact our office or the US Department of State for specific requirements.
