Required Documents for Title and Registration

- Original title complete with:
 - Seller's printed and signed name(s)
 - Buyer's printed and signed name(s)
 - Buyer's physical address
 - Purchase Date
 - Purchase Price
 - Odometer mileage and indicator (if applicable)
 - Notarized (if required on title)
- If there is more than one owner, a completed DR 2395: Joint Tenancy with Rights of Survivorship is required: <u>CLICK HERE FOR ALL FORMS</u>
- Current proof of insurance for the new vehicle
- Completed <u>Bill of Sale</u> that is notarized or signed under penalty of perjury in the second degree is required for:
 - Any title that does not have a "Purchase Price" field
 - Obtaining a temporary registration when the title is unavailable
 - Must be signed by both the seller(s) and buyer(s)
- Must obtain a passing Enhanced Emissions Test for Gas Vehicles 6 years and older and Diesel Vehicles 3 years and older for the following:
 - Passenger Vehicles, Buses, Light trucks, Recreational trucks, GVW trucks, GVW tractors, Motor homes
 - For emissions testing locations for Gas Vehicles 6 years and older visit: <u>aircarecolorado.com</u>
 - For emissions testing locations for Diesel Vehicles 3 years and older visit: <u>dmv.colorado.gov/diesel-vehicles</u>
- Loan documents (if vehicle is being financed) that include:
 - Borrower's name and address
 - Lienholder's name and address
 - Year, make, and VIN of vehicle
 - Loan amount
 - o Loan date
 - Borrower's signature
- If the vehicle is titled in any state other than Colorado, a completed DR 2698 Verification of Vehicle Identification Number is required and must be completed by one of the following: <u>CLICK HERE FOR ALL FORMS</u>
 - Colorado licensed dealer
 - Colorado Law Enforcement
 - Colorado emissions testing centers
 - It is recommended to call ahead for pricing and availability

- Certified weight slips are required for:
 - Cargo vans, and motorhomes weighing between 4501 lbs. to 10,000 lbs.
 - All trailers over 1,900 lbs. except trailer coaches measuring 26 ft. or longer not including the hitch
 - Any truck weighing between 4,501 lbs. to 10,000 lbs. that has been modified over 300 lbs., or if weight cannot be verified by the state system.
 - Can be obtained at any location with a certified scale (rock/landscaping yards, truck stops, etc.). It's recommended to call ahead for pricing and availability.
- An owner must present Secure and Verifiable Photo Identification (SVID) as outlined on form DR 2841: <u>CLICK HERE FOR ALL FORMS</u>
- Once all paperwork is collected and complete, skip the wait time and <u>click here to</u> <u>schedule an appointment at a Douglas County Motor Vehicle office location</u>
 - Walk-in service is available Monday Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm

PLEASE NOTE: The vehicle owner must be present and provide SVID, VIN or plate number, and a form of payment. Cash, card, check, and money orders are accepted (card payments may incur additional fees).
