Allow Douglas County unrestricted access to the site to conduct regular site inspections;</li> <li>2. Comply with all requirements of the GESC Manual, accepted GESC plan, and Small Utility GESC Permit;</li> <li>3. Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of Douglas County. A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this Permit revoked if the Permittees are not in compliance with the GESC Permit, GESC Plan and/or GESC Manual, or the Permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance;</li> <li>4. Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of this Small Utility GESC Permit shall constitute a violation of the Stormwater Ordinance No. O-013-001 and</li> <li>5. Understand any approval obtained from Douglas County does not obviate your need to comply with the requirements of the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Colorado Discharge Permit System, General Permit, and Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, 16 U.S.C. 1531, <u>et seq.</u>, as amended, or with any other applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations.</li> </ol>
