Elections Division

Our Elections team was responsible for the conduct of two elections in 2025: the June Douglas County

Special Election called by the Board of County Commissioners and the November Coordinated Election featuring state, municipal, school district and special district contests.

throughout the county for each election, along with convenient in-person voter service and polling centers, makes voting easy and accessible.

The number of registered voters in Douglas County increased by 1% in 2025. 52% of Douglas County voters are unaffiliated, 31% are registered with the Republican party and 16% are registered with the Democratic party.
