

CDPHE Moves Douglas County to More Restrictive Level on State's COVID-19 Dial Framework

On November 17, 2020 CDPHE notified Douglas County that, effective November 20th, it would be moved from Level Orange to the more restrictive Level Red on the state's *COVID-19 Dial*, based primarily on increasing incidence rates in Douglas County and across the State. Summary of Capacity Differences Between Level Orange and Level Red in Douglas County, Colorado

Effective November 20, 2020 no later than 5:00 PM.

Business or Activity	Safer at Home Level Orange	Safer at Home Level Red
Events (receptions, conferences, etc.)	Indoors: 25% capacity per room up to 50 (excluding staff). Outdoors: 25% of posted occupancy within usable space up to 75 (excluding staff).	Indoors: Closed. Outdoors: 25% of posted occupancy within usable space up to 75 (excluding staff).
Field Services	May operate. Real estate open houses must follow Indoor Event requirements.	Only those necessary to maintain the safety, sanitation, and critical operation of residences, Critical Businesses, or Critical Government Functions may operate. Real estate open houses allowed with no more than one household in the property at a time.
Gyms	25% capacity up to 25 per room or outdoor area (excluding staff).	Reservations required for all indoor and outdoor services. Indoors: 10% capacity up to 10 per room (excluding staff). Outdoors: 10 or fewer individuals.
High School Sports	May resume practices and games under disease prevention and mitigation plans prepared by the Colorado High School Athletic Association (CHSSA) and approved by CDPHE.	Same as Level Orange.
Indoor Mall	Park Meadows variance remains in place: 50% capacity per confined indoor space up to 175.	Park Meadows variance remains in place: 50% capacity per confined indoor space up to 175.
Indoor Pools	25% capacity up to 50 per room.	Reservations required. 10% capacity up to 10 per room (excluding staff).
Libraries	May provide services as a Critical Business.	May provide services as a Critical Business.
Office-based Business, Critical	Must follow social distancing requirements.	Same as Level Orange.
Office-based Business, non-critical	Allowed to operate with staff at up to 25% posted occupancy.	Allowed to operate with staff at up to 10% posted occupancy.
Personal Services (spas, salons, etc.)	25% capacity per room up to 25.	Same as Level Orange.
Places of Worship and Life Rites	25% capacity per room up to 50 (excluding staff).	Same as Level Orange.
Restaurants	25% capacity per room up to 50 (excluding staff).	Closed for indoor dining. May offer curbside, takeout, and delivery. Outdoor dining only for members of the same household at a table.
Retail, Critical	Allowed to operate at 50% of posted occupancy.	Same as Level Orange.
Retail, Non-critical	Allowed to operate at 50% of posted occupancy.	Same as Level Orange.
Social Gatherings	Up to 10, no more than 2 households.	Prohibited unless specifically allowed in a separate category.
Team Sports	Prohibited indoors. Up to 10 outdoors.	Same as Level Orange.
