

## CDPHE Moves Douglas County to Less Restrictive Level on State's COVID-19 Dial Framework

On February 6, 2021 CDPHE moved Douglas County from Level Orange to the less restrictive Level Yellow on the state's *COVID-19 Dial 2.0*. ### Summary of Capacity Differences Between Level Yellow and Level Orange in Douglas County, Colorado

Business or Activity	Level Yellow	Level Orange
Aquariums, Museums, and Similar Educational Institutions	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff).*	25% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff).
Events (receptions, conferences, etc.)	Indoors: 50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff).* Outdoors: 50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 175 people, per usable space (excluding staff).	Indoors: 25% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff). Outdoors: 25% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 75 people, per usable area (excluding staff).
Field Services	May operate. Real estate open houses must follow Indoor Event requirements.	Same as Level Yellow.
Gyms	50% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area.*	25% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area.
High School Sports	May resume practices and games under disease prevention and mitigation plans prepared by CHSSA and approved by CDPHE.	Same as Level Yellow.
Houses of Worship (and associated ceremonies such as weddings, funerals, and baptisms)	May provide services under Critical Business guidelines.	Same as Level Yellow.
Indoor Mall	Park Meadows variance remains in place: 50% capacity per confined indoor space up to 175.	Same as Level Yellow.
Indoor Pools	50% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area.*	25% capacity up to 50 patrons per room or outdoor area.
Libraries	May provide services under Critical Business guidelines.	Same as Level Yellow.
Office-based Business, Critical	May operate under Critical Business guidelines.	Same as Level Yellow.
Office-based Business, Non-critical	Allowed to operate with staff at up to 50% of posted occupancy.	Allowed to operate with staff at up to 25% of posted occupancy.
Personal Services (spas, salons, etc.)	50% capacity per room up to 50.	25% capacity per room up to 25.
Restaurants	50% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff). Establishments larger than 7,200 SF may expand to up to <b>150</b> people per room.	25% of posted occupancy, not to exceed 50 people, per room (excluding staff).
Retail, Critical and Non-critical	Allowed to operate at 50% of posted occupancy.	Same as Level Yellow.
Social Gatherings	Up to 10, no more than 2 households.	Same as Level Yellow.
Recreational League Sports	Activities with no more than 25 players (excluding coaching staff and referees or umpires) are allowed. Leagues may request permission from CDPHE to operate in accordance with CHSSA requirements.	May operate indoors or outdoors with not more than 10 players. Leagues may request permission from CDPHE to operate in accordance with CHSSA requirements.

\* Establishments larger than 7,200 SF may expand to up to 100 people or patrons per room.
