

APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSE PERMIT
Pending Transfer of Ownership Approval

This application must be filed with the Douglas County Licensing Clerk, with a check made out to: Douglas County for required fee of **\$100.00**. All questions on this application must be answered. **Notice:** Any individual, Corporation, Partnership, or Limited Liability Company, Association or Other Entity applying for a temporary permit is charged with the responsibility of having knowledge of the pertinent Colorado State Statutes and Regulations as set forth in C.R.S. Title 44, Articles 3 and 4.

This application must be accompanied with:

- Complete Transfer Application
- Appropriate Transfer Fees
- \$100.00 Check made out to Douglas County for a temporary license

- Applicant (If an LLC, name of LLC; If partnership, at least two partner's names; if corporation, name of corporation)

- Trade Name

- Name of Current Licensee to be Transferred

- Trade Name of Current Licensee to be Transferred

- Address of Current Licensed Premises

NOTE: A temporary liquor license permit may be issued only if a completed application for transfer of ownership along with all required documentation and associated fees have been submitted to the Douglas County Liquor Licensing Clerk.

An Affidavit of Transfer and Statement of Compliance signed by both Applicant and the Licensee must be submitted with the application packet.

Applicant must have legal possession of the premises.

A temporary liquor license permit is valid for no more than one hundred twenty days from the date of issuance and is automatically void upon completion of the transfer of ownership and issuance of a new permanent liquor license in the name of the above Applicant by the Colorado Division of Liquor Enforcement and the Douglas County Local Licensing Authority.

This permit may be canceled, revoked, or summarily suspended if the Local or State Licensing Authority determines there is probable cause to believe that the transferee has violated any provision of the Colorado Liquor/Beer Code or has violated any rule or regulation adopted by the Local or State Licensing Authority or has failed to truthfully disclose those matters required pursuant to the transfer to the transfer application forms.
